We will visit the Museo Chileno de Arte Precolombino, a jewel among the world's museums and a highlight of any trip to Chile. Widely regarded as one of the best museums in Latin America, this unique establishment houses an impressive collection of ancient artefacts from Central and South America, which highlights to all visitors the hugely rich cultural and artistic diversity of the pre-Columbian Americas.

The Palacio de los Tribunales de Justicia de Santiago is the home of the Supreme Court of Chile, the Court of Appeals of Santiago, and the Court-martial Court of the Chilean Army, Chilean Air Force and Carabineros de Chile. Occupying an impressive amount of real estate in the front of Compañía Street between Bandera and Morandé Streets. The building diagonally faces the Palacio de la Real Aduana, which is home to the Museo Chileno de Arte Precolombino. You can see Mont Varas Square directly in front the Palacio.

Travel back in time as you visit the manor, explore the wine cellars, and learn about the winemaking processes. Taste some of the country's finest wines as you indulge in gourmet dishes at the winery's restaurant "La Casona de Doña Paula". We will also visitthe Alto Jahuel Andean **Museum** to see a private collection that includes pre-Colombian objects that belonged to different Chilean cultures.

Located on the banks of the Mapocho River, the Parque Bicentenario has a large lagoon with flamingos, black-necked swans and Koi fish swimming among lotus plants. After a stroll in the park, we will head to Las Condes district where after visiting the historical cathedral of San Vicente Ferrer, we will browse the colorful workshops and stalls in the market. ## President's DinnerClub de la Unión

Founded on July 8, 1864, the Club de la Unión was founded as a meeting place for conservative and liberal groups of the country, both for debate and for social and political meetings, and today continues to serve as a meeting place for the Santiago community.

Its current headquarters was built in 1925 under the presidency of Don Luis Barros Borgoño by the architect Alberto Cruz Montt, and the building was declared a national monument in 1981 which is home to one of the most significant art collections in Chile. The Club de la Unión is characterized by its marked French style of the early twentieth century. The harmony and elegance of its infrastructure make it one of the most beautiful buildings in Chile.
