In addition to hosting international sporting heroes over the years, the site has been a popular choice for global superstars such as Michael Jackson, Rihanna, Madonna, ACDC, Robbie Williams, Billy Joel, Michael Bubl  and Lady Gaga. Friday evening will mark a first as the venue hosts international leading family lawyers joining to celebrate the IAFL's 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.
